

# GARLICAP

Garlic Oil 10 mg Soft Gelatin Enteric Coated Capsule

Botanical name : *Allium sativum*

## Herbal Anti-Hyperlipidemic



### Composition

Each soft gelatin enteric coated capsule contains Garlic Oil 10 mg.

### Description

*Allium sativum* (Garlic) has been used medicinally, most recently for its cardiovascular, antineoplastic and antimicrobial properties. Allicin appears to be the active component of the garlic plant. Studies show significant but modest lipid lowering effects and anti platelet activity.

**Garlicap is in enteric coated form which inhibits stomach irritation and also reduces garlic bad odor.**

### Indications

1. Hyperlipidemia
2. Arteriosclerosis
3. Hypertension

### Dosage & administration

Hyperlipidemia and arteriosclerosis : 2-3 capsules daily.

Hypertension : 1 capsule three times daily.

### Side effects

In rare instances there may be gastrointestinal symptoms, changes to the flora of the intestine or allergic reactions.

### Precautions

Garlicap should be used with caution in patients with severe peptic and duodenal ulceration. It is wise to avoid taking Garlicap in empty stomach.

### Contraindications

Garlicap is contraindicated for children (Age below 12 years).

### Drug interactions

Concomitant use of Garlic Oil with anticoagulants such as coumarin, antiplatelets such as aspirin and dipyridamole can increase the risk of bleeding.

### Use in pregnancy & lactation

No teratogenic effect is found. Not recommended during lactation.

### Storage

Keep out of reach of children. Keep away from direct sunlight.

Store below 25° C in a dry place.

### Supply

Each box contains 5 x 10 = 50 soft capsules in blister pack.
