

Peppermint Oil 0.2ml Soft Gelatin Enteric Coated Capsule

Botanical name: Mentha arvensis



Composition:

Each Soft Gelatin Enteric Coated Capsule Contains Peppermint Oil 0.2ml.

Indication:

Peppermint oil relaxes gastrointestinal smooth muscle and relieves flatulence and colic. It is also used in irritable bowel syndrome (IBS).

Dosages & administration:

Adult: One capsule three times daily for up to 2-3 months, increased to two capsules three times daily if necessary. The capsule should be taken half to one hour before taking food or as directed by a registered physician.

Side effects:

Heart burn, irritation, rarely allergic reaction including rash, headache, bradycardia etc.

Use in pregnancy and lactation:

There are no adequate and well-controlled studies in pregnant women. It is not known whether peppermint oil is excreted in human milk.

Drug Interactions:

Reaction may be more likely if peppermint oil is taken in conjunction with alcohol, enteric coated capsule containing peppermint oil should not be taken immediately after food or with antacid.

Contraindications:

Peppermint oil is contraindicated in patients who exhibit hypersensitivity to any component of this medication.

Precautions:

It is used in precaution in Gastroesophageal Reflux Diseases (GERD), Liver Diseases and Diabetic Mellitus.

Storage:

Keep out of reach of children. Keep away from direct sunlight. Keep store in a cool and dry place.

Packing:

Each box contains $5 \times 10 = 50$ soft capsules in blister pack.
