Dandelion 425mg

Botanical Name: Taraxacum Officinale



Composition:

Each capsule contains Dandelion 425mg.

Description:

The plant is perennial, hardy, and is found in a number of forms. It grows to about 30cm tall and has a short rhizome. The rhizome turns into a many headed. The basal leaves are glabrous or villous, usually deeply notched, lanceolate and lobed like a saw.

Indication:

Dandelion is indicated for-

- * Dyspeptic complaints
- * Infection of the urinary tract
- * Liver & gallbladder complaints
- * Loss of appetite

Dosages & administration:

1-2 Capsules 2-3 times daily, Or, as directed by the registered physician

Side effects:

No health hazards are known in conjunction with the proper administration of designed therapeutic dosages.

Contraindications:

Contraindications include closure of the biliary ducts, gall bladder empyema and ileus.

Use in pregnancy & Lactation:

No experience is available about the use of Dandelion in pregnant & lactating mother.

Drug Interactions:

Concurrent use of dandelion with anticoagulants, antiplatelet agents and thrombolytic agents may result in increased risk of bleeding. Concomitant use with fluoroquinolones may result in decreased fluoroquinolone effectiveness. Caution is advised if Dandelion and these medications are taken concomitantly.

Precautions:

Consult with a doctor is necessary in the presence of biliary ailments.

Storage:

Store in a cool and dry place away from sunlight. Keep it out of reach of children.

Packing:

Each box contains $8 \times 4 = 32$ capsules in Alu-Alu blister pack.
