Composition :

Lactulose 3.35g/5ml Oral Solution.

Indications : DLAC is indicated for the treatment of constipation and hepatic encephalopathy.

Dosages:

In Constipation	Daily dosages
Adult	3 teaspoonfuls twice daily
6 - 12 years	2 teaspoonfuls twice daily
Below 5 years	1 teaspoonful twice daily
Below one year	1/2 teaspoonful twice daily

Oral Solution

Hepatic encephalopathy : 6-10 teaspoonfuls 3 times daily, subsequently adjusted to produce 2-3 soft stools daily. Or as directed by a registered physician.

Adverse effects : Flatulence, diarrhea and abdominal discomfort may occur.

Precaution : Lactose intolerance

Contraindication : Galactosaemia, gastro-intestinal obstruction or hypersensitivity to any component of the drug.

Use in pregnancy and lactation : Lactulose has been assigned to pregnancy category B by the FDA.

Drug interactions : The glycosidic effect of cardiac glycosides can be intensified by potassium deficiency in abuse.

Packing : 50ml, 100ml, 200ml in each bottle.
