Composition: Calcipotriol BP 0.05 mg. **Indications**: This ointment is indicated for the topical treatment of chronic stable plaque type psoriasis in adult patients.

Dosage and administration: A thin layer of this ointment should be applied to the affected skin once or twice daily and rub in gently and completely. Or, as directed by the registered physician.

Side effects: The side effects of this ointment are-photosensitivity reaction, skin discoloration, bullous eruption, skin exfoliation, contact dermatitis and allergic reactions.

Contraindications: It is contraindicated in those patients with a history of hypersensitivity to any of the components of the preparation. It is also contraindicated in patients with known disorders of calcium metabolism.

Drug interactions : There are no known drug interactions with this ointment.

Precautions: It is not recommended for use in patients with generalized postural psoriasis, guttate psoriasis and erythrodermic exfoliate psoriasis.

Use in pregnancy and lactation:

Pregnancy: Safety for use in pregnancy has not been established. Therefore it should not be used during pregnancy unless benefits clearly outweigh the risks. **Lactation:** It is not known whether Calcipotriol is excreted in breast milk, therefore, the drug should be used during lactation only if the benefits clearly outweigh the risks.
