Composition: Cefuroxime+Clavulanic Acid (125mg+31.25mg), (250mg+62.5mg) (500mg+125mg) Tablet & (125mg+31.25mg)/5ml Suspension.

Indications: It is indicated for the treatment of patients with mild to moderate infections caused by susceptible strains of the designated microorganisms in the conditions listed below: Pharyngitis/tonsillitis, Acute bacterial otitis media, Acute bacterial maxillary sinusitis, Acute bacterial exacerbations of chronic bronchitis and secondary bacterial infections of acute bronchitis, Uncomplicated skin and skin-structure infections, Uncomplicated urinary tract infections, Uncomplicated gonorrhea, Early lyme disease.

Dosage and administration: The usual course of therapy with Fuclav tablets is 5 to 7 days for treatment of bronchitis and 7 to 10 days for other infections. Indications & dosage of Fuclav tablets are given below:

Side effects: Diarrhea, nausea, transient elevation in AST, ALT, LDH, abdominal pain, abdominal cramps flatulence, indigestion, headache.

Precautions: Before therapy with Fuclav is instituted, careful inquiry should be made to determine whether the patient has had previous hypersensitivity reactions to cephalosporins, penicillins or other drugs.

Pregnancy and lactation: Pregnancy Category B. Drug interactions: Concomitant administration of probenecid with cefuroxime axetil increases the area under the serum concentration versus time curve by 50%. Drugs that reduce gastric acidity may result in a lower bioavaitability of Fuclav compared with that of fasting state and tend to cancel the effect of postprandial absorption.
