**Composition :** Fusidic Acid 2% and Hydrocortisone Acetate 1%.

Indications: Fusibac-H cream is indicated in eczema and dermatitis with secondary bacterial infections, including atopic eczema, primary irritant dermatitis and allergic and seborrhoeic dermatitis where the organisms responsible are known to be or believed to be sensitive to fusidic acid.

## Dosage & administration:

## Adults and children:

Uncovered lesions - apply gently, three or four times daily.

Covered lesions - less frequent applications may be adequate. Or as directed by the physician.

**Contraindications**: As with other topical corticosteroid preparations, Fusibac-H cream is contraindicated in primary bacterial, viral and fungal skin infections.

Precautions: Caution should be exercised, however, when Fusibac-H cream is used near the eye. Steroid-antibiotic combinations should not be continued for more than 7 days in the absence of any clinical improvement.

**Side effects**: Hypersensitivity reaction to the active ingredient in the form of skin rashes and mild stinging and irritation on application, have been reported rarely.

## Fusibac-H

**Use in pregnancy and lactation :** The safety in pregnancy and lactation has not been established for fusidic acid.

Packing: Fusibac-H cream: 10gm in a tube.
