Composition: Mupirocin 2%.

**Indications**: Muron ointment 2% is indicated for the topical treatment of impetigo due to: Staphylococcus aureus and Streptococcus pyogenes.

Dosage and Administration: A small amount of Muron ointment should be applied to the affected area three times daily. The area may be covered with a gauze dressing if desired. Or as directed by the registered physician.

**Contraindication**: This drug is contraindicated in individuals with a history of sensitivity reactions to any of its components.

**Side effects**: Adverse effects such as burning sensation, stinging and itching, rash, erythema, dry skin, swelling, systemic reaction have been reported with this ointment.

Precaution: If reaction suggesting sensitivity or chemical irritation with the use of Mupirocin ointment 2%, treatment should be discontinued and appropriate alternative therapy for the infection instituted. As with other antibacterial products, prolonged use may result in overgrowth of nonsusceptible organisms, including fungi. It is not formulated for use on mucosal surfaces. Mupirocin ointment is not for ophthalmic use.

Pregnancy and lactation: Pregnancy Category B.

Packing: Muron Ointment: 10gm in a tube.
